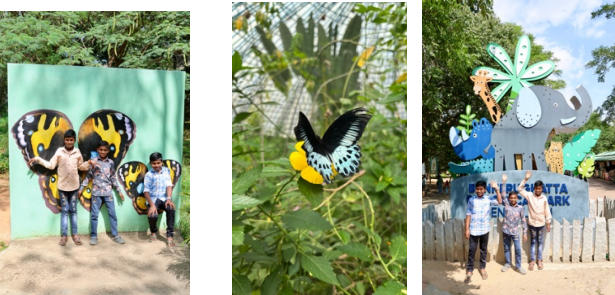
Once again we'd like to share about our work in India.

THE KIDO

Our boys are healthy and happy. Sometimes one of them has a cold, because it's winter and cold at night in India. In the last few weeks we experienced a lot together. I was with a friend for 2 weeks in India. Together with the boys we went to the Bharagata Nationalpark in Bangalore. There we did a safari in the bus. Lots of animals we saw very close. Sometimes it can be dangerous, some animals can become aggressive and hit the bus or break tires.



After the safari we went to the butterfly park and the zoo. Wild animals are nothing so special for our boys, in their village where they grew up are tigers and elephants living. Even though, they enjoyed a lot and were so happy. The butterfly park was amazing.



Everyone was fascinated. And the zoo was also great. The way between the animals was quite long, so we



used an electric vehicle. On the way back home we went to a restaurant for food. Everyone was hungry after such a beautiful, interesting day. Ganesh said, the food was the best of that day. He really enjoyed

the food, but also the whole trip. He got also new shoes, because he came without, and to go to the park it was obligatory to wear shoes. We also went for another trip to Hogenakkal for boating. Anbu cooked in the morning a big pot of Briany Reis. It was very tasty and nice but too much. So we decided to take it with us as a picnic. We had lunch at the Kavary river and where we watched by a big monkey



sitting on the tree. Later, Monkeys stole our fruits out of the car, because by the hired car we couldn't any more close the window. They didn't eat the rice, only opened the cover. So in the evening, we thought about what to do with the leftover of the rice. At this moment a very poor young lady with 2 kids came to greet me. When she saw us 2 white ladies, she remembered her childhood. She told me, that she's grown up in a hostel and sometimes she saw a white lady from America, which visited them. So I had a small conversation with her. I asked her about her family and if she has food for tonight. She has denied, as I already feared. So we searched for plastic bags, filled her all the rice in and given it to her. She was so thankful, it was enough for her family for one meal. In my heart I felt so happy, I could help someone needy and poor. *The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me'. THE SCHOOL

The school runs very well. Now, the kids are writing the semi-annual exam. The teachers and the principal lady are a good team. Regularly there is a meeting taking place. There are a lot of small kids in



our school at lunch they take a break, sleep on the floor or on the table. The lunchtime is also quite short for the small, ¾ hours. That's often not enough time for them, but they can finish the meal. There are each



day 7 lessons for them. The school language is English. The teachers are often challenged with the



kids. Anbu and the principal lady are preparing the papers for the 10th standard. To be able to go forward, it needs always the right connections to people, to get help from them. It's wonderful to see, how God is giving Anbu always again the right people to his side. Please pray, our paper will soon be worked out and we will get a positive answer.

THE CONSTRUCTION WORK



Still, we are building, mainly inside work is going on. The electricians, the plumper and the carpenter and some more are at work. By the 2. Entrance we have to pour on soil and level the ground. For this we build a small wall as support. Because if there is heavy rain, often all the soil is washed out. To bring up all the fresh water and to bring down all the dirty water we have to fix pipes outside of the house. The wastewater then flows into a tank which can be pumped out if necessary. By the 2. Building we fixed first the floor with cement, now we are covering it up and preparing the roof.



MISSION WORK

Anbu met a man which had a bad accident. He fell from a tree and broke his leg. It was operated on, but the wound healed poorly. Again, and again pus came. He sought help from his Hindu gods and made a lot of sacrifice. They pay a lot on money, finally had only 1 meal a day. A pastor who works with us met him. He tells him about Jesus Christ, the true God who can give healing. The man listened with interest and then said a surrender prayer. Jesus was the last hope for him and his family. And really, the wound healed better, the pus became less. Now the whole family goes to church and they grow in faith. Even in their environment, many are amazed by this Jesus. Please pray that his wound will heal completely and that other friends of him also get to know God.
