OUR CHILDREN

At the end of April our boys had all gone back home and spent their holidays. After that, only 1 boy, Ganesh, who is now the 10. School year attending came back. Families of the other 2 thought it was better if their boys came back to their village. Unfortunately, any conversations didn't change this decision. Now they go to a school, where rarely a teacher is present and they are taught bad. Parents are probably not concerned with education, but with using their child to work. There you can see what is a priority for poor uneducated people. In June 2027 we want to take in new children, when the house is also ready.

NEW CONSTRUCTION CHILDREN'S HOME

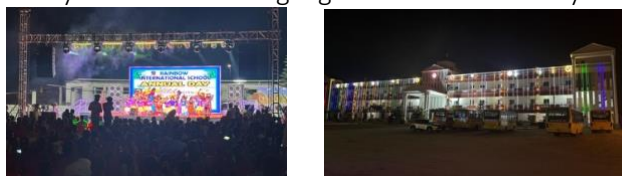
The last works are made in the house of boys. The 2nd House for the girls is quickly getting bigger. The



work is going well. Stone by stone is put build up, walls are built and one after another floor is added.

THE SCHOOL

In the first week of June, school started again. Now we have about 300 Children who come to our school every day. The Team of teachers has also changed a little. Now 2 male teachers also teach at our School. Anbu and the headmistress are working on the papers for the authorisation until the 10th School year. This, in turn, requires some visits to the offices. In April we celebrated the graduation again with the students and their parents. The school festival is always one of the highlights of the school year.



We are thankful to run the school now for the 5th year. In 2022 we started. We are so thankful to God

and you all to support this work.



SOLAR PROJECT

Since the power supply in India is often very poor and depends on the weather or the will of people, we have decided for solar electricity. On the schoolhouse and on the boy's home. We have calculated everything and have already been faithfully supported for this project. Now we were allowed to put the solar power into operation on the roof of the school building on 26.06.26. We have in total 14 solar panels of 1m 03 cm each. That gives 8.50 square meters on the first place and at the 2nd place it's 6.30 square meters. That's enough for the school building, for any electricity. We can also pump up our groundwater with it. If the solar power is not enough, then we can also change to electricity from



the village. We all together inaugurated the solar system with prayer. We gave thanks and praise to our God, and sweets filled our mouths with joy. We are very grateful for this good investment. We can save an expensive electricity bill every month. Here the school building shines in the evening for the first time with its own solar power. There is a backup battery to store the electricity. If we have to much power from the sun, we can give it to the electricity net of



the village. Next, we plan the solar system on the boy's house as soon as this house is finished. The costs will be around 12'000 Euro. We enjoy the sun for our electricity, but also wish to have rain in India. It is also very hot there and there has been almost no rain yet. But we are grateful to still have our own groundwater.

MISSION

We were allowed to preach the gospel in 5 villages. There were many hurdles to overcome, because 2 men had acted very energetically against the pastors. That's why we decided to fast for 3 days and pray. That opened the doors, now today 350 people have heard the Gospel of Jesus Christ for the first time. We have launched new Bible groups for young men and women, so that they can be strengthened and grown in faith. God works for many people with healing of infirmities. This is also how this yoga teacher was able to experience God. He had kidney stones and went to the doctor, took medication and prayed to his Hindu gods. There was no answer and his pain was persistent, despite medication. Then he heard of Jesus Christ. He came to the house congregation, he knelt down, prayed together with the pastor and begged God for help. After the prayer the pastor gave him a glass of water to drink and the same evening the kidney stone was washed out. *"He sent out his word and healed them, and delivered them from their destruction."* Psalm 107:20 Today now he joyfully tells what he experienced with God, gives God the honour for what he has done in his own life. Truly, God is a wonderful Savior, better than any doctor.

Prayer meetings of pastors are regularly held in our house. Pray that the people who are God's servants may be protected God & guided with the holy spirit.

OUR NEXT VISION

Our future vision is to empower and educate lady's. We like to build a nursing school/college, where ladies can become in 1 to 3 years a nurse, diploma and bachelor course. The ground Anbu has already reserved. It is around 1 km away from Grace Home. We still have to buy it. The land cost will be 350'000 Euro for 7 Hectors. We like to self-support women's not to be too much depending on their husbands, because India is a male dominated society. If a lady has an education, the poverty rate may go down, family crises will be easier solved and child marriage may be stopped. We appreciate your help, uphold us in prayer and financial support for this project to bless young ladies in India.
